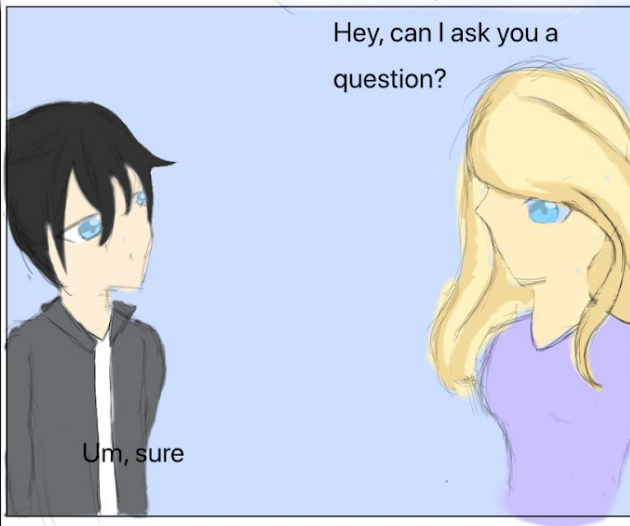


Well I was wondering why me and my friends got into different universes and colleges?

Um, sure

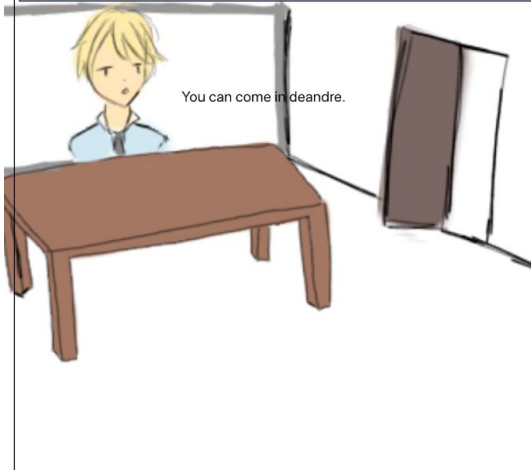


Do you think it's fair that me and my friends got into different colleges and universities?
