Translated Video Transcript:

Anchor: A youth ambassador program called “Live Well, Take Action” received \$317,000 funding from the Ontario Trillium Foundation. It has been the fourth consecutive year of this program. Through a variety of extra-curriculum projects, combining discussion about culture with community services, this program enhanced the awareness of identities of East Asian students, and motivated them to create social change.

Elizabeth Yeoh: I am really glad I decided to take part in the program because I was able to learn so much about what being Asian Canadian means to me and others in my community, and as well, I have been able to make many friends who I probably wouldn't have spoken to if it wasn't for the program.

Jeffrey Su: My time at “Live Well, Take Action” allowed me to realize and integrate what I have learned in various aspects of my life, making sure it's bringing us a sort of awareness to public issues that “Live Well, Take Action” discusses.

Anchor: This program was organized by ALPHA Education and Chinese Canadian National Council Toronto Chapter. Over fifty projects have been provided in four years. More than 150 East Asian students from seven high schools in York Region have participated in this program. A student celebration will be held at the end of April (postponed to May 26th, 2022).
