The “Live Well, Take Action” program recently had their Student Celebration for its participants.

On the 28th of May, program participants, parents, teachers, and special guests came to the event held at Thornhill Secondary School, Ontario. More than 120 people attended the program in total.

Created in partnership with ALPHA Education, the “Live Well, Take Action” program spanned 8 weeks and involved 43 students. The students formed groups to make projects that were displayed at the final event.

5 students took turns being the MCs for the event.

CBC producer Steven Zhou was also invited to share his experiences as an Asian-Canadian and the important roles that they should play in society.

This program, led by Alpha Education and the Chinese Canadian National Council Toronto Chapter, has championed the awareness of social issues, self-esteem, and mental health. The program is funded by the Ontario Trillium Foundation, and is expecting schools from the Toronto District School Board to participate in future programs as well.
